Workforce Preparation Orientation

Every Wednesday - 10:30 am to 12:00 Noon (1-1/2 hours)

This orientation provides an excellent introduction to job search resources, including the WorkSource Career Center, the Job Hunter workshop series, other community resources available for job seekers, and information on employment and training services.

No eligibility requirements - all customers may attend.

Included in this orientation is information on eligibility requirements and the application process for employment and training services for low-income youth (16-21) and low-income adults (22+) and for persons who have lost their job and are unlikely to return to that occupation or industry due to a plant closure, mass layoff, foreign competition, or lack of demand for their skills (dislocated workers).

Dislocated Workers and low-income youth and adults seeking employment and training assistance.

Senior Employment Connection

Every 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month, 4:00-6:00pm (2 hours)

For Job Seekers 55 years or over interested in additional support locating employment opportunities. Friendly introduction to job search technology, resume assistance, networking, and access to the WorkSource Career Center. This orientation provides information on available training for those who meet eligibility requirements.
